Furthermore, all officers will provide IDPs and refugees with legal advice, and in addition to an excellent knowledge of the relevant laws to enable the realisation of rights, a commitment to help this vulnerable group is a precondition. Particular focus needs to be placed on the completion and solution of outstanding cases which have been filed a long time ago by previous EU-funded projects. This contract is a continuation of contract financing from IPA 2011.
