The goal of this project is to contribute to the increase of capacity and safety of environmentally sound and sustainable inland waterway transport on the Danube river (part of TEN-T core network corridor Rhine–Danube) in full accordance with the EU regulations and standards, national legislation in the Republic of Serbia as well as Danube Commission requirements.

Thus, technical assistance services are needed for the preparation, procurement and implementation of the several project components that should result in a fully implemented and functioning navigation monitoring and reaction system on the Danube river. In particular, technical assistance will perform:

- project management, coordination, review of the tender documentation for the supply and system integration,
- supervision of compliance of implemented AtoNs system with already existing RIS system,

- supervision of implementation of AtoNs in line with actual RIS standards and user needs,
- supervision of development, integration and operation of specific components of the AtoNs system.
