The goal of this project is the implementation of the Serbian energy sector development strategy in the renewable sector by facilitating investments in SHPPs in order to obtain the goal of construction of around 180 MW of new generation capacity from SHPPs in the national GFEC up to 2020 according to NREAP.

Through this contract, technical assistance should develop a new cadastre for SHPPs on the territory of the Republic of Serbia. The cadastre of SHPPs should cover the small hydro power plants with estimated power between 100 kW and 10 MW. It should cover SHPPs, SHPPs that are currently in construction, and identified new locations.

The whole territory of Serbia should be divided into several river basins, that should present organisational units for the data input and access. The activities should inter alia cover the identification of current state, methodology development, defining data, software development and presentation of the new cadastre for the SHPPs and software usage, that should include training sessions for the usage of the software application and visibility events.
