#### 6. Nature of contract

## 7. Contract description

The goal of this project is the implementation of the Serbian energy sector development strategy in the renewable energy sector by facilitating investments in small hydro power plants (SHPPs) in order to obtain the goal of construction of around 180MW of new generation capacity from SHPPs in the national GFEC (gross final energy consumption) up to 2020 according to National Renewable Energy Action Plan (NREAP).

Through this contract, technical assistance should develop a new cadastre for SHPPs for the territory of The Republic of Serbia with estimated power between 100 kW and 10 MW. It should cover existing SHPPs, SHPPs that are currently in construction, and identified new locations.

The whole territory of Serbia should be divided into several river basins that should present

organisational units for the data input and access. The activities should inter alia cover the identification of current state in river basins, methodology development for the assessment of locations for SHPP, defining data for cadastre sheets, software development and presentation of the new cadastre for the SHPPs and software usage, with included capacity building and awareness rising on the Cadastre for SHPPs.

### 10. Scope for additional services

The Contracting Authority may, at its own discretion, extend the project in duration and/or scope subject to the availability of funding up to a maximum not exceeding the length and value of the initial contract. Any extension of the contract would be subject to satisfactory performance by the Contractor.

# CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

### 11. Eligibility

Participation is open to all legal persons participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see item 29 below). All goods supplied under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. Participation is also open to international organisations. Participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

#### 12. Candidature

All eligible natural and legal persons (as per item 11 above) or groupings of such persons (consortia) may apply.

A consortium may be a permanent, legally-established grouping or a grouping which has been constituted informally for a specific tender procedure. All members of a consortium (i.e., the leader and all other members) are jointly and severally liable to the Contracting Authority.

The participation of an ineligible natural or legal person (as per item 11) will result in the automatic exclusion of that person. In particular, if that ineligible person belongs to a consortium, the whole consortium will be excluded.

# 13. Number of applications

No more than one application can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting an application). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than one application, all applications in which that person has participated will be excluded.

## 14. Shortlist alliances prohibited

Any tenders received from tenderers comprising firms other than those mentioned in the short-listed application forms will be excluded from this restricted tender procedure unless prior approval from the Contracting Authority has been obtained (see Practical Guide – PRAG- 2.4.3.). Short-listed candidates may not form alliances or subcontract to each other for the contract in question.

#### 15. Grounds for exclusion

As part of the application form, candidates must submit a signed declaration, included in the standard application form, to the effect that they are not in any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.3.3 of the PRAG

# 16. Sub-contracting

Subcontracting is allowed

#### 17. Number of candidates to be short-listed

On the basis of the applications received, between 4 and 8 candidates will be invited to submit detailed tenders for this contract. If the number of eligible candidates meeting the selection criteria is less than the minimum of 4, the Contracting Authority may invite the candidates who satisfy the criteria to submit a tender.

# SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

#### 21. Selection criteria

Same criteria for legal and natural person

The following selection criteria will be applied to candidates. In the case of applications submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

- 1) <u>Economic and financial capacity of candidate</u> (based on item 3 of the application form). In case of candidate being a public body, equivalent information should be provided.
  - a) The average annual turnover of the candidate over the last three years (2011, 2012 and

b) Average current ratio (current assets/current liabilities) over the last three years (2011, 2012, 2013) must be > 1.

### 2) Professional capacity of candidate (based on items 4 and 5 of the application form)

a) At least five (5) permanent staff currently works for the candidate in fields of hydrology engineering and/or engineering

### 3) Technical capacity of candidate (based on items 5 and 6 of the application form)

(a) The candidate has provided services under at least two contracts (with value of the activities in the project carried out by the legal entity being at least EUR 750.000, e.g. at least 50% in case overall contract value of EUR 1.500.000) in any of the following fields: design of small hydro power plants, or pre-feasibility and/or feasibility studies for small hydro power plants, or hydrology analysis, which were implemented at any moment during the following period: in the course of the past 3 years (starting from 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2011. up to the deadline for receipt of application).

For selection criteria listed under 21.3 this means that the projects the candidate refers to could have been started or completed at any time during the indicated period, but it does not necessarily have to be started and completed during indicated period, nor implemented during the entire period. Candidates are allowed to refer either to projects completed within the reference period (although started earlier) or to projects not yet completed. In the first case the project will be considered in its whole if proper evidence of performance is provided (e.g. final report approved, statement or certificate from the entity which awarded the contract, proof of final payment). In case of projects still ongoing only the portion satisfactorily completed during the reference period will be taken into consideration. This portion will have to be supported by documentary evidence (similarly to projects completed) also detailing its value.

If a candidate has implemented the project in a consortium, the percentage that the candidate has successfully completed must be clear from the documentary evidence, together with a description of the nature of the services provided if the selection criteria relating to the pertinence of the experience have been used.

Previous experience which caused breach of contract and termination by a Contracting Authority shall not be used as reference.

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It must in that case prove to the Contracting Authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of eligibility and notably that of nationality, as the economic operator.

If more than 8 eligible candidates meet the above selection criteria, the relative strengths and weaknesses of the applications of these candidates must be reexamined to identify the eight best candidates. The only factors which will be taken into consideration during this re-examination are:

1) The total number of reference projects found eligible under criterion 21.3.; and in case of equality on this criterion, then

2) The value of the eligible part (the value of the activities carried out by the candidate) of the projects found eligible under criterion 21.3.
